<u>Zauntee</u> - Zauntee is a modern hip hop artist from Tampa, Florida, who has a large following and has become known for his distinctive sound and motivational lyrics.

<u>Blanca</u> - a Puerto Rican-born American Contemporary Christian music singer-songwriter. Prior to going solo she was a member of the Christian hip-hop band, Group 1 Crew.

<u>RaJan Monroe</u> - Des Moines, Iowa native with deep roots from the hip-hop culture, RaJan shares his lyrical ability and embraces the emotion of life within his songs.

Saturday

Jordan Feliz – Coming from Nashville, Feliz has been nominated for five Dove Awards and in 2016 was awarded "New Artist of the Year." His first single "The River" spent 12 weeks at #1 on Billboard's NCA Chart and recently went Platinum. His music is described as folk rock and soul style of Christian pop. <u>Ellie Holcomb</u> – CCM-folk singer-songwriter raised in Nashville, Tennessee. Ellie's debut, As Sure As The Sun (2014), landed her a Top 10 hit with "The Broken Beautiful" and a GMA Dove Award for "New Artist of the Year." Her album - All of My Days was recently released.

<u>The Trampolines</u> - Trampolines is an explosive electronic band propelled by missional purpose that has taken them all around the world. They've performed on stages in front of as many of 50,000 people, with their touring experience spanning 40 U.S. states and over 20 countries.

Awaken the Dust – A North Iowa worship leader collective. They have been making music together for several years with various projects and in 2023 they obeyed the Lord's call to open for CAIN and Rend Collective. They love to lift up the name of Jesus through music and faith stories!

Brian Herrin - A classically trained singer-songwriter. In 2008, he co-founded the band Decoy. From 2008-2015, he performed hundreds of shows and recorded two albums. Brian is set to release a new solo album in 2024.

<u>Allie Crummy</u> - Singer/songwriter based in Des Moines, Iowa has released three albums, two EPs, and a few extra singles to date. Her style is mostly a mixture of pop and soul brimming with emotion. **Greg, Carolyn, and Emily** - Siblings from Clear Lake who have led worship in the area for many years. Their familial harmonies and instrumental arrangements put a modern spin on beloved hymns.

<u>Jacob and Julia Petersen</u> (Social Media Personalities / Emcee) – Jacob, a Clear Lake native now living with his wife, Julia, in Arkansas, describes their mission "to give insight on the things we are learning in our everyday lives while walking with Jesus." (Friday and Saturday)
